Dog neuter package:

- Less than 40 pounds \$200
- 40 to 80 pounds \$275

Dog spay package:

- Less than 40 pounds \$325
- 40 to 80 pounds \$375

All packages include the spay/neuter surgery, rabies vaccine, distemper vaccine (if first dose, \$15 booster needed in 3-4 weeks), microchip, nail trim, ear cleaning, E-collar, post-op pain medication, and one-time flea/ear mite treatment if needed.

Diarrhea, vomiting, weight loss, skin disease, etc) and do not provide follow-up or long-term care management. NHHS offers no after-hours or emergency care.
