Cat spay OR neuter package:	\$150
Dog neuter package:	\$250
Dog spay package:	\$350

All spay/neuter packages include: spay/neuter surgery with tattoo, rabies vaccine, microchip, nail trim, E-collar, post-op pain medication, and one-time flea/ear mite treatment (if needed). There are no discounts for any declined/unnecessary services. Rabies vaccination and microchip are REQUIRED and may only be declined with proof of current rabies vaccination or if already microchipped. A tattoo to indicate that your pet is sterilized is REQUIRED and may not be declined.
